

# FUTURE POSSIBILITIES

**New** landscaping patterns are evolving along Plainfield Avenue! Some of the projects, which the CIA will undertake in the next 15 years, are traffic access improvements, street intersection improvements, and pedestrian access improvements. They will work on utility improvements and street-scape modifications. Parking improvements as well as storm water management, landscaping, and site acquisition and redevelopment are also part of the master plan. Discussion is taking place on entrances to the development district, public transportation, storefront architectural enhancements, and uniform sign standards. In the future, discussion will include the possibility of a small park area and perhaps some non-motorized trails.

**Some** future targets for the PACIA will be the old Witmark Building on the corner of Jupiter and Plainfield (pictured below), the addition of sit-down restaurants along Plainfield, and also, hopes for a CVS drugstore springing up in our corridor.


