Sec. 8-101. - Assignment. 

The address assigned by the county road commission to any property in the township shall be the number to which reference is made in this article.

Sec. 8-102. - Placement of numbers. 

Street address numbers shall be located in the following manner:

(1)

The owner or occupant of any structure assigned a street number and located at a distance no greater than 90 feet from the closest street right-of-way shall display said number in a prominent place on the structure in a manner so as to be readily visible during normal daylight hours to occupants of emergency vehicles on the street.

(2)

The owner or occupant of any structure assigned a street number and located at a distance greater than 90 feet from the closest street right-of-way shall display said number in a prominent place on the structure. In addition, said numbers shall be displayed on a prominent sign or plate, or on a mailbox, located on the same side of the street as and directly in front of the structure and at a distance no greater than ten feet from the street right-of-way in a manner so as to be readily visible to occupants of emergency vehicles on the street.

The township fire chief or his deputy may modify the regulations of this article or may require the placement of additional numbers upon a determination that such action is necessary to ensure compliance with the intent of this article.

Sec. 8-103. - Specifications for numbers.

Street address numbers shall be designed as follows:

(1)

Said numbers shall be constructed of durable material, and shall be of a color which contrasts with the background upon which located.

(2)

Said numbers shall be arabic in style.

(3)

Said numbers for residential structures shall be at least three inches in height. For all other structures, the numbers shall be at least four inches in height.
