



**VOTER REGISTRATIONS:**

If you have any questions about voting, please visit the Michigan Secretary of State's web site at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote) and follow the instructions to check your voter registration, see a sample ballot, get instructions on using voting equipment, important election dates or maps showing precinct locations. The last day to register to vote for the November 4, 2008 General Election was October 6, 2008. A person who registered by mail is not allowed to vote an absent voter ballot in their first election. They must go to the polls on Election Day.

**POLLING HOURS:**

The polls are open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Many people go to vote on their way to or from work. During these times, the polls are very busy and there probably will be lines. *Please vote absentee if you qualify* or plan to go to the polls during the middle of the day, if it is possible.

If the student registered online or by mail, the student must vote in person in their first election unless they have had their identification checked by a Clerk. Please call the Clerk's office to make special arrangements for the ID to be verified.

- I expect to be absent from the community in which I am registered for the entire time the polls are open on Election Day, or
- I am physically unable to attend the polls without the assistance of another person, or
- I am 60 years of age or older.

Absent voter ballots are available in the Clerk's office during regular business hours. Voters may complete the application, receive a ballot, and vote immediately, if they desire. The township offices are located at 6161 Belmont Avenue NE, Belmont. The office hours are 7:30 AM - 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday.
